# Youth Sports – Parent Code of Conduct

## Preamble

The essential elements of character-building and ethics in sports participation are embodied in the concept of sportsmanship and six core principles: trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring and good citizenship. The highest potential of sports is achieved when competition reflects these “six pillars of character.”

## I therefore agree:

- I will remember that children participate in sports to have fun and that the game is for the youth, not adults.
- I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
- I will learn the rules of the game and the policies of the league.
- I (and my guests) will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice and other sporting event.
- I (and my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player or parent such as booing and taunting; refusing to shake hands; or using profane language or gestures.
- I will not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and wellbeing of the athletes.
- I will teach my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
- I will demand that my child treat other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, color, sex or ability.
- I will praise my child for competing fairly, executing the required skills and trying hard to improve.
- I will emphasize skill development and individual effort over winning.
- I will cultivate age-appropriate expectations for my child and his/her teammates.
- I will promote the emotional and physical well-being of the athletes ahead of any personal desire I may have for my child to win.
- I will respect the officials and their authority during games and will never question, discuss, or confront coaches at the game field; I will take time to speak with coaches at an agreed upon time and place.
- I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free from illegal drugs, tobacco, alcohol and vulgar language, and I will refrain from their use at all sports events.
- I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the official coaches of the team.

I also agree that if I fail to abide by the aforementioned rules and guidelines, I will be subject to disciplinary action that could include, but is not limited to the following:

- Verbal warning by official, head coach and/or head of league organization
- Parental game suspension with written documentation of incident kept on file by BPRD; child suspension will result if parent is suspended
- Parental season suspension
- Referral to legal authorities

# Youth Sports-Student Code of Conduct

**Respect, privacy, honesty and positivity are required of YOU, student athlete, at all times while participating in any sport at BPRD. Bullying, shaming, harassment and/or taunting of any kind will not be tolerated, either with actions or words.**

**Respect-** due regard for the feelings, wishes, rights, or traditions of others

**Privacy-** the state or condition of being free from being observed or disturbed by other people

**Honesty-** free of deceit and untruthfulness

**Positivity-** the practice of being or tendency to be positive or optimistic in attitude

**Bullying-** seek to harm, intimidate, or coerce someone

**Shaming-** causing someone to feel ashamed or inadequate by outdoing or surpassing them

**Taunting-** intended to provoke someone in an insulting or contemptuous manner

**Harassment-** aggressive pressure or intimidation

## **I therefore agree:**

1. I will give *respect* to my fellow teammates and adults within the building of BPRD at all times.
2. I will give my teammates *privacy* while in the locker room and keep myself to myself, including my eyes. There is never a good reason to be staring at someone in the locker room while they are changing.
3. I will practice *honesty* at all times.
4. I will have a *positive* attitude.
5. I will not *bully* my fellow teammates in any fashion or form.
6. I will not *shame* my fellow teammates under any circumstances.
7. I will not *taunt* my fellow teammates at any time.
8. I understand that *harassment*, of any kind, will not be tolerated ever.
9. I will not rough house or make a mess in the locker room, gymnasium, or other parts of the facility (for example-throwing soap in the shower, eating food in the gym, leaving trash on the floor). I understand that it is my responsibility to leave the facility in a BETTER condition than when I found it. If the facility is found dirty after my practice or game, the next practice my team and I will be required to clean in place of our scheduled practice. This is YOUR facility, student athlete, and you need to take some pride of ownership in it.
10. I understand that there will not be an adult present in the locker rooms and I am required to act with the upmost respect and honesty while using this private facility.

**I also agree that if I fail to abide by the above listed rules, I will be subject to disciplinary action that could include, but is not limited to the following:**

- Receiving a verbal warning from coach/parent volunteers/BPRD staff
- Being benched for 1 or more practices
- Being removed from the team (no refund or credit will be given)
- Referral to legal authorities (as required for abuse)
